

We have started!

On Monday the 23^e of May the project “*expedition tunnel Koningin Julianaplein*” officially started. For the surrounding the start is become visible by the fences, which are placed around the construction site. We are still very busy with the preparations to lead the construction “*expedition tunnel Koningin Julianaplein*” on the right track. What you can expect in the coming weeks and what consequences this entails will be explained in this newsletter.

Global planning

The construction cabin will be placed on the site on Wednesday the 1^e of June.

When this is completed, the chief will be physically on the construction site from that moment.

The site is closed and is only accessible for transport and construction staff.

Visitors must first sign in and are only aloud to be on the construction site with guidance.

We will manage the number of daily transport movements by using just-in-time delivery of material and equipment. Loading and unloading is done within the fences of the construction site.

The first work on the sheet pile sections is expected to be completed in week 25.

From that week, the drainage, earthwork and the substructure of the expedition tunnel will start. the project is expected to be completed at the end of August.
