

Route Directions New Babylon City Tower

Anna van Buerenplein 51 to 282 • The Hague

Getting there

Follow the signs toward The Hague Central Station. Via the Bezuidenhoutseweg, turn into the Prinses Irenestraat. Drive between New Babylon and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, toward the Anna van Buerenplein.

1. Barriers (House of Representatives)

Located between the entrance of Q-Park CS – New Babylon and Coolblue.

- Moving companies, suppliers and technicians must be registered in advance by the resident with the servicemanager.
- Announce yourself at the intercom with your company name (or license plate if you have no company name).
- After verification the barriers are opened remotely – you will gain access to the loading and unloading area.

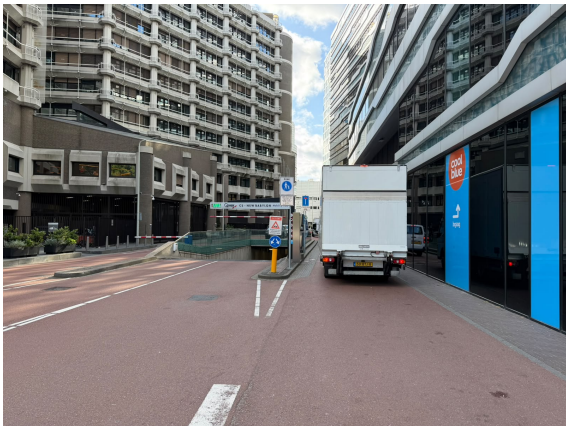


Photo 1 – arrival at Anna van Buerenplein, by Coolblue

2. Bollards

Keep right until you reach the bollards. Accessible without exemption:

- Weekdays: 05:00–07:00 and 10:00–11:30
- Weekends: 06:00–11:30

Outside these hours, a bollard exemption from the Municipality of The Hague is required (bollard **P180**). Application form:

3. To the City Tower

After the bollards, turn right at walking pace, continuing toward the City Tower (the tall tower near Central Station). Drive around the corner and park as close as possible to the building, directly next to the moving area – preferably nose-in between Albert Heijn and the moving area. This keeps you closest to the entrance, leaves room for a second vehicle, and keeps the way clear for an ambulance or fire brigade if needed.

You may drive out at any time. If the vehicle remains on the square outside bollard hours, place a visible phone number behind the windscreen so enforcement officers can contact you. This reduces the chance of a parking fine.

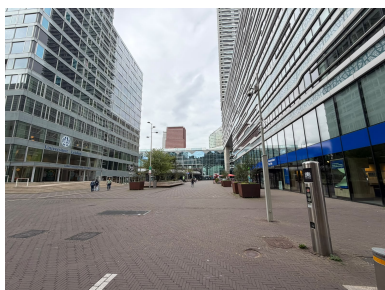


Photo 6 – Anna van Buerenplein, toward City Tower: drive all the way to the end, then right

4. Moving area

The servicemanager or resident can open the side door to the moving area. It is forbidden to use the automatic side door with the yellow floor marking, or to move via the main entrance hall.

If booked in advance, the servicemanager can direct you to the moving lift, which can be set to service mode so that moving can proceed undisturbed.
